



PUBLIC NOTICE ABSENTEE VOTING


Voters begin to vote by Absentee Ballot on Friday, September 23, 2016. Absentee voting will be available at Hastings City Hall, 101 Fourth Street East between 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m., Monday-Friday through Friday, November 4th. Absentee voting will also be open from 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. Saturday, November 5th and until 5:00 p.m. on Monday, November 7th, 2016. The General Election will be Tuesday, November 8th, 2016.

State law allows eligible Minnesota voters to vote absentee either by mail or in person without reason.

To vote absentee by mail, visit the [Secretary of State's Website](#) to download and print an absentee ballot application, or contact [Dakota County](#) or [City of Hastings](#) to obtain one.

There are special voting procedures for active-duty military personnel, their dependents, and Minnesotans overseas. This office encourages these voters to visit <https://minnesota.overseasvotefoundation.org>, a one-stop-shop developed by the Office of the Secretary of State in partnership with the Overseas Vote Foundation, to assist these voters in requesting their absentee ballots.
