

2023 Budget at a Glance

The City's budget intends to be a financial plan that prioritizes high quality services in a fiscally responsible manner. The process to develop the budget is a collaborative effort of the city budget team, the finance committee of the council and the management team. Careful planning and preparation ensure our CORE Values guide the way.

The 2023 Property Tax Levy is \$17,373,405

The property tax levy is the primary funding source for services such as police protection, fire protection, and parks and recreation. In 2023, the City levy is increasing 6.62%. However, due to growth within the city, the property tax rate will decrease 5.64% from the previous year. The property tax levy will result in 2023 City property taxes of approximately \$1,571 on a median value home.

- ♦ \$1.79 Facility Maintenance
- ♦ \$26.95 Insurance, Debt, Obligations**
- *Additional funding for Community Development is provided by the HEDRA levy, which is \$429,211, and is in addition to the City's 17.3 million.
- **The City's debt supports assets such as theAquatic Center, Riverfront Renaissance, Street Infrastructure, Fire Trucks and other similar items.
